smart motorway programme: M1 junctions 13 to 16



I am writing to update you on the progress of the above scheme.

We will be switching the traffic management from the central reservation to the verge between junctions 13 and 14. Safety is our number one priority, so we will be carrying out this work using a full carriageway closure.

In addition to these works, we will be removing large trees from the verge adjacent to your property on the M1, using specialist machinery with the capability of cutting and lifting trees away from the verge and then chipping the wood/timber into adjacent vehicles.

We will do our utmost to complete the work as quickly as possible and keep noise and disruption to a minimum. However, we acknowledge some operations may cause noise, for example, wood chippers and reversing beepers which must be operational on our vehicles for health and safety reasons.

We will be carrying out overnight closures as detailed in the schedule overleaf. Please note these are provisional dates and are subject to change, as there may be conditions outside of our control; such as adverse weather, and incidents on the network. We ask drivers to follow the signed diversion routes during these closures. Please do not use satellite navigation (sat nav) when following the diversion, as they may give conflicting information. Please refer to our website for the strategic diversion routes. Please be considerate of residents living along the diversion routes when travelling during these closures.

We advise residents and business owners to allow extra time to complete their journeys.
