

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS IN CENTRAL MILTON KEYNES - COVID-19) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2021 (No.2)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on **5<sup>th</sup> January 2021** made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Council is satisfied that by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public during the Coronavirus pandemic (Covid-19) that the following temporary measures be introduced to help provide a safe and controlled parking area for the vaccination facility in Central Milton Keynes (CMK).

The effect of the Order will be as follows: -

- 1) To enable Milton Keynes Council to temporarily close **Saxon Gate** (west side), CMK – between Avebury Boulevard and South Row.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the following exemptions will apply: -

- Visitors (by appointment only)
- Staff working at the temporary Vaccination Centre
- Emergency service vehicles

- 2) To enable Milton Keynes Council to temporarily close **South Row**, CMK – between South Seventh Street and Saxon Gate.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the following exemptions will apply: -

- Staff working at the temporary Vaccination Centre
- Emergency service vehicles

*Please note the above road closures will only take effect when necessary and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.*

- 3) To temporarily alter the parking restrictions in South Row, CMK – between South Seventh Street and Saxon Gate, by introducing V1 permit parking for staff working at the vaccination centre.

All road closures will be advertised and clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

The temporary Order will come into effect on **18<sup>th</sup> January 2021** and will remain in effect for a period of **18-months** and will only take effect at times when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
